- Educated: A Memoir by Tara Westover**
Traces the author's experiences as a child born to survivalists in the mountains of Idaho and her resolve to educate herself.
- The Lost City of the Monkey God by Douglas Preston**
Takes readers on an adventure deep into the Honduran jungle in a danger-filled true story about the discovery of an ancient lost civilization.
- This Is How It Always Is by Laurie Frankel**
Claude is the youngest of five boys, but Claude is not like his brothers. Claude says he wants to be a girl when he grows up. This is how a family keeps a secret – and how that secret ends up keeping them.
